Talking about socialization process, socializing is very important for all human beings, particularly in the educational system. We need to socialize with each other. It's not only with students but also with the faculty, the non teaching staff, with students, their parents and the community as a whole. So we

need to follow the socialization process in a proper manner.Coming to the term socialization, it is used to describe the process of learning a new role and how to behave in a new setting. Socialization of teachers is a process through which individuals come to appreciate the values, knowledge and behavior associated with the profession of teaching and it proceeds through specified stages. Now, What is anticipatory socialization process? Anticipatory socialization is a period of formal training including student teaching, during which aspects of the teachers work are learned and certain expectations are developed. This happens in our training Institute. You need to train the students how to socialize with each other, along with your students , also so it may happen in a simulated condition, but then it can also happen in the real classroom situation, so this will be taught to the students to learn about how to socialize with each other during this period. Positive rather than negative aspects of the role are usually emphasized.and ideal rather than realistic teaching practices are Generally aught. Not now we come to the impact of one's own socialization process on becoming a teacher and it's

limitation. This is particularly with respect to the beginning. teachers who have just entered the teaching profession. It appears that during the early stages of their careers, beginning teachers are most concerned about their interpersonal adequacy, that , whether their students and supervisors and parents are going to like them. These problems and feelings are quite natural, at some point it varies for different individuals, and they may also disappear at one time. Beginning teachers have special challenges not faced by the new role occupants in other professions because of the way education and schools are organized. This is because in educational system or the schools we follow a particular organized way of behaving. Also the ways how things are carried out with respect to having a proper timetable schedule, having a proper curriculum which is prescribed for different grades. Also the ways how to teach and assist the students. So, it is always systematic. organization which has been followed in a teaching system. Now discipline problem seems to belong to the beginning teachers. It happens that most of the time when the teachers try to interact or give a class to the students, you may find that problem to manage the classroom is seen and this

happens with the beginning teachers. But as the time passes and managing the entire class becomes very easy. So beginning teacher should be ready to make a good impression when the students arrive the first day, they should greet students at the door in a friendly and pleasant manner. If inappropriate behavior is observed, a beginning teacher must correct it immediately.Now, being friendly will help the student or the entire class to be comfortable with you and they feel very free to be in your class and they are interested in the teaching learning process. When you see the discipline problems happen, you need to discipline the class right from the beginning, otherwise it will be very difficult for you to manage the class later on. A beginning teacher should expect to be nervous during the first few minutes of student contact, he or she must guard against such behavior and remain visible to students regardless of personal discomfort. As the bell rings, the teacher should be ready to start immediately, introduce yourself to the class in a firm voice and extend a formal welcome to your students. This helps to create a good rapport with your students in the first class itself. Teachers should start acquainting students with one another on the first day of the school so they try to introduce

to each other,get to know each other and this helps them to do well later on when they have group discussions and other participatory activities in the class. Select a very

interesting topic and by planning that lesson based on the information about students prior knowledge, you need to begin the class with a very interesting topic and something that they already know and you're continuing in a logical sequence. This helps the students to be more comfortable, able to listen to your lecture, and they are more interested. Lessons during the first day and the first week should be. uncomplicated and should focus on the entire class. This is because you have children with the individual differences and they learn at their own pace. So, you need to take a topic which is less difficult for them and it should cater to the needs of each and every student in your classroom. Also provides for important rules. Explain the logic behind the rules and then teach them exhibiting leadership, and attending to one's professional growth is also another important function for launching a beginning teachers career You need to cater to your professional needs by attending the seminars, workshops, orientation and refresher courses that helps to building on, grow and develop in
