To begin with, a population is the number of living things that live together in the same place. A city population is the number of people living in that city.

These people are called inhabitants or residents.

The population includes all individuals

that live in that certain area. Population density is the average number of people in a place.

Urban areas such as big cities have a high population density. Mostly they live close to each other. In areas with a low population density,

People usually live far away from each other, such as in rural areas out in the countryside.

Usually population refers to the number of humans in a certain area.

The maximum population that can be supported.

In an area it is called carrying capacity.

Now we will learn about population geography.

Population geography as an independent sub field of human geography is a comparatively recent phenomenon. Geography of the population is one of the most well established branches of general geography. As it had been suggested, growing availability of population statistics has played an important role in the emergence of population geography.

Population is not the study of population, but it is meant for the population awareness and population consciousness of the good and bad effects of the population growth and its remedial measures. It is the education about population growth and its majors.

It is the education about population matters like fertility, mortality and migration, and its remedial measures to check the rapid growth of population. It aims at the growth of the qualitative life of the people. In the various fields of health care.

A population study is a study of a group of individuals taken from the general population who share a common characteristics such as age, sex or health condition.

Now we learn the meaning of the population Geography

The geographical study of population involving its spatial distribution, dynamics and movement. As a sub discipline, it has taken at least three distinct but related forms, the most recent of which appears increasingly integrated with the human geography in general.

Pioneer by Glenn Trewartha, Wilbur Zelinsky William A.V. John .I. Clark and others in the USA as well as Jacqueline Beujeu - Garnier and Pierre George in France.

It has focused on the systematic study of the distribution of population as a whole, and this spatial variation in population characteristics such as fertility and mortality.

Now we will learn the definition given by different scholars, thinkers about population geography.

First, we have Glenn Trewartha.

According to Trewartha, population geography is concerned with the understanding of the regional differences in the Earth covering of people. He even wrote a well known paper A case for population geography in the year 1953 he describe in his paper, as it talks about race, religion and custom are mentioned, but he does not speak about the ethnic groups or languages through. He has an extremely broad conception of population geography.

Next we have John Clark.

He has given the definition of population geography according to Clark "Population Geography is mainly concerned with demonstrating how spatial variation in population and its various attributes like composition, migration and growth are related to spatial variation in the nature of places.

Next we have Wilbur Zelensky. He defines it as a science that deals with the ways in which geographic the character of places is formed by and in turn, reacts upon a set of population phenomena that vary within it, though through both spaces and time Interactive one with another and with numerous non demographic phenomena.

Moreover, population geography had been defined as a branch of geography that studies the distribution of the human population over the terrestrial surface.

To conclude, with population geography studies the distribution of population over the surface of the Earth along with its characteristic and relation with the geographical personality of the region.
