<i>Ashrapradhan Mandal-</i>	Council of Ministers consisting of eight ministers
<i>Peshwa or Mukhya Pradhan-</i>	Prime Minister
<i>Amatya or Mujumdar--</i>	Finance Minister
<i>Mantri or Waqianavis--</i>	Chronicler
<i>Nyayadhish-</i>	The Chief Justice
<i>Pandit Rao or Danadhyaksha -</i>	Religious Head
<i>Sachiv or Shuru Navis-</i>	Superintendent
<i>Sarnaubat or Senapati-</i>	Commander in Chief
<i>Sumant or Dabir-</i>	Secretary on foreign affairs
<i>Hawaldar-</i>	In-charge of the fort
<i>Karkhanis -</i>	In-charge of stores
<i>Phadnavis</i>	Keeper of administrative records
