Glossary

Treaty-a formally concluded and ratified agreement between states.

Diplomacy-the art of dealing with people in a sensitive and tactful way.

Cordial-warm and friendly.

Sovereignty-supreme power or authority.

Naval-relating to a navy or navies.

Strategy-relating to the identification of long-term or overall aims and interests and the means of achieving them.

Neutral-not supporting or helping either side in a conflict, disagreement

Hostility-unfriendliness or opposition

Fleet-a group of ships sailing together, engaged in the same activity, or under the same ownership

Ammunition-a supply or quantity of bullets and shells.

Beseige- a place surrounded by armed forces aiming to capture it or force surrender.

Treaty-a formally concluded and ratified agreement between states.

Vessel-a ship or large boat.

Territory-an area of land under the jurisdiction of a ruler or state.

Cartaz-was a naval trade license or pass issued by the Portuguese in the Indian ocean during the sixteenth century ,under the rule of the Portuguese empire

Merchandise-goods to be bought and sold.

Ambassador-a representative or promoter of a specified activity.
