Glossary of terms/words:

- Migration - A form of spatial mobility of population between the geographical units.

Periodic Migration - This is a temporary movement of cultivators to the place of employment during the slack seasons of agricultural year.

Semi- Permanent Migration - It is movement to the place of work, characterized by occasional visits to the native place and a final return to the home in the old age.

Permanent Migration - It occurs due to some serious uprooting factors e.g., superior attraction elsewhere or serious calamities at home and overcrowding etc.
