The different committees of the Constituent Assembly were Drafting Committee of seven members was set up with Dr. B.R. Ambedkar as its chairman. The other important members of the Committee were Sir Alladi Krishnaswami Ayyar, K.M.Munshi, T.T.Krishnamachari and Gopalaswami Ayyangar, Mohammad Saadulla and N. Madhav Rao.

Dr. B.R. Ambedkar was a brilliant writer. His study of constitutional law was thorough. He took a very prominent part in the deliberations of the Constituent Assembly. He was forceful and persuasive in his arguments.

Jawaharlal Nehru He was the central figure throughout the deliberations of the Constituent Assembly. He was always ready to make his contribution on any Article of the Constitution. The Union Constitution Committee and the Provincial Constitutions Committee were set up under the Chairmanships of Jawaharlal Nehru.

Rajendra Prasad He played an important role in the Constituent Assembly. He conducted the meetings of the Constituent Assembly with dignity and impartiality.

Sardar Patel He always spoke with authority and was able to silence his opponents. His contribution was largely with regard to the problem of States and Minorities.
