figures who played a very important role in the

contribution to the different committees that were set up

under the guidance of the

constant assembly. The first person was Mr. Jawaharlal Nehru He

was the person who presented the report of the Union Powers

Committee. He was also the chairman of the Union

Constitution Committee. We all know that the Valero was also the 1st Prime Minister of India and other leading figure of the constant assembly who also was a member of many committees.

Ann is contributed a lot of work and effort in draw, helping to drop some of the provisions of the Constitution was Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel. He presented the report of the Advisory Committee on Fundamental Rights and Minorities, and he was also the chairman of the Provincial Constitutions Committee. Besides these two individuals who were mainly in charge.

The committee is the constituent assembly. The constant assembly drew up a sub committee which is known as the drafting committee.

The first person who played a very important role in the whole process of drafting the Constitution for India was

Doctor BR Ambedkar. Doctor Ambedkar was a brilliant writer.

He was all had very good knowledge of the constitutional law. Because of his contribution and his ideas. He's also called as the chief architect or the father of the Constitution of

India. Another person who was though not a member of the drafting committee but sought to the overall functioning of the constant drafting of the Constitution was Doctor Rajendra

Prasad. He played an important role in the constant assembly.

It was under his guidance that all the proceedings of the constant assembly were carried out smoothly and impartially.

Sir, Alladi K Iyer was instrumental in largely influencing certain chapters of our Constitution, and these were largely the fundamental rights. The provisions of the Supreme Court and the High Court. His Knowledge of constitutional law was very excellent.

KM munshi. He also helped draft the resolution.

All the Rules of Procedure that had to be followed by the members of the Assembly.

So K. M. Munshi, he was also a brilliant lawyer.

Yet another member of the Constituent Assembly who also played an important role in drafting the constitution was Maulana AbulKalam Azad. He was a member of four committees of the Constituent Assembly. These committees were the AdvisoryCommittee, the Steering committee, the UnionConstitution Committee, and the States Committee.

Another important member of the constituent assembly was an Gopalaswamy Ayyangar. He was a great asset to the drafting committee. He played an important role with regard to the question of language to be adopted. His knowledge was largely helpful to the members of the constituent assembly and helped handling those provisions that deal with administrative details.

Frank Anthony he was a member who represented the Anglo Indian community in the Constituent Assembly. His contribution is largely seen in the field of education. There are many schools in India which had been named after him.

Pandit Govind Pant. He was a leading lawyer and a very high ranking congressman. He was a member of three committees of the constituent assembly, the Union Subjects Committee, Union

Constitution Committee, and advisory committees. You see friends from all the committees that I've discussed with you. All the members of the different committees of the Constitution have played their role there, given in their time, the efforts, their knowledge, their experience from their varied fields, and helped to draft a constitution for India. Thanks to all the effort, their guidance, knowledge that we have a Constitution of India that has worked.

And continues to work even today. Through this you realize that drawing up a constitution for India was not a simple task. It was a mammoth job and we have to be largely grateful to all the members of the constituent assembly. The members of the different committees who put in their ideas, their efforts and knowledge to draft one of the best constitutions in the world.
