Here we're going to learn the module - types of tourism wherein we are going to study to Domestic and international tourism inbound and outbound tourism international tourism and myself,

So a brief outline of this course - types of tourism.

Under that we are going to learn domestic and international tourism, inbound and outbound tourism, intra regional tourism and international tourism.

After completion of this module, students you will be able to understand and describe international and domestic tourism. Explain the concept of inbound and outbound tourism. Explain the concept of Inter and intra regional tourism.

So let's go to the topic.

As you know,

there are many types of tourism, so the types of tourism can be recognized based on different modes of transport used by the tourist or the length of the stay of the tourist, or the price paid by the tourist. Or it can be based on the purpose of the travel of the tourists.

So in a broader sense, these tourism can be divided into four types mainly.

Domestic tourism,

international tourism,

inbound tourism and outbound tourism.

So let's first see the domestic tourism. So domestic tourism is a tourism involving resident of 1 country

traveling only within that country. So here what happens is the activities of the tourist of the resident country that is traveling to or staying in within that country, but out of their usual environment is considered, and their stay should not be more than twelve consecutive months.

It does not require a passport or visa or conversion of 1 currency into another domestic tourism

has greater scope in countries of larger dimensions such as India is compared to smaller countries.

So next we'll go to the

international tourism.

So international tourism is a tourism that crosses national borders where an international tourist crosses the boundaries of many countries, uses different currencies, face different languages and meet different types of people as compared to your domestic tourism.

So usually international tourism involves longer distances, although crossing small countries or traveling in the neighborhood of international border may involve short distances.

So next we'll go to inbound and outbound tourism,

so broadly speaking, international tourism has been divided into further two types that is inbound tourism and outbound tourism.

So in case of inbound tourism here, the visitors from overseas coming into the country so generally when we refer to the term inbound tourism in India we are referring to the people from different countries traveling to India for example or tourists coming from US to India can be termed as inbound tourist.

So next type is outbound tourism.

Here it refers to traveling to a different country for a visit or a holiday. So generally when we refer outbound tourism in India, we refer to the Indian resident traveling out of India.

For example, you are outbound tourists from India. If you are going to Spain for a holiday or a visit.

So next is intra regional tourism, practically speaking, international tourism is known as intra regional tourism.

Here the tourist traffic flow to and from countries within the same region of the globe or it is relatively more significant in developed regions like Europe, America as compared to developing regions like Africa and South Asia.

For example, intra regional tourist is someone from England traveling to France.

So here what he is doing is he just traveling from one country to another country within his own continent.

So he will be termed as intra regional tourist.

Next is inter regional tourism, So here Travel between distinct areas is called Inter –Regional Tourism. Inter-regional tourism is the movement from one region of a country to another. Inter-regional tourist: someone from England visiting Japan. An inter-regional tourist is someone who visits an "exotic" location. In case of Domestic travel it could be person from Hyderabad travelling to Delhi.
